

Edenton Town Council Minutes
Committee Meeting
June 22, 2020

The Edenton Town Council met on Monday, June 22, 2020 at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers. The following members were present: Mayor Jimmy Stallings, Councilman Elton Bond, Councilman Roger Coleman, Councilman Samuel Dixon, Councilman Hackney High and Councilman Roscoe Poole. Absent was Councilman Craig Miller.

Mayor Stallings called the meeting to order.

The Administrative Committee had three items on the agenda.

Councilman High stated that the first item was the Young Folks Committee, next steps.

Councilman High stated that 12 applications have been received and recommended over the next couple of weeks the committee meets with all who applied for the committee. It was recommended to try and schedule appointments with those interested in serving.

Councilman High stated that the second item was the Human Relations Commission, next steps.

Councilman High stated that it was time to start recruitment for applicants to serve on the Human Relations Commission. He recommended to talk with Dr. Valarie Batts to begin mapping out the purpose of the committee and how to form the committee.

Councilman High stated that the last item was an update on the timeline for planning for new or renovations to the high school.

Ms. Knighton gave the Town Council an update and reported that the County Commissioners recently held a public hearing and adopted a resolution calling for a special referendum for the levying of a one quarter cent sales tax. The County Commissioners also adopted a resolution that if the voters confirm the sales tax increase that it be set aside for the school fund.

The Public Works Committee had one item on the agenda.

Ms. Knighton stated that the item for review was the stormwater assessment, phase 1 report.

Anthony Roper & CJ Jackson with SEPI Engineering was present to give a report to the Town Council.

There being no further items on the agenda, the meeting was adjourned.
