- **4.** Promoting equality of opportunity and participation with a focus on town staff positions, town boards and commissions, and town supported organizations

## 2024 Initiatives for the HRC

- 1. Focus on helping to celebrating all citizens and their cultures by helping to create a calendar for ethnicity events or holidays to share with the public;
- 2. Help Co-sponsor and vet various organizations that plan to host events that multiple organizations would like to take part in;
- 3. Focus and share the educational needs for housing and rental options for all residents
  - Identify opportunities to educate citizens on the homebuying process and financial management
  - b. What are the best rental options? Whole home, apartments, duplexes?
    - i. What does the market rate need to be for affordability?
  - c. Roommate finder to lower cost and increase affordability similar to dorms.
- 4. Partner with the Town of Edenton to determine eligible housing projects to provide sustainable rental options for residents
  - a. Shelter Locations for Homeless
    - i. Churches or Non-profit
- 5. Help identify recreation improvements opportunities that the Town can control.
  - a. Help with neighborhood parks redesign.
  - b. Recreation opportunities for those with disabilities and the elderly
  - How do we get young adults to volunteer as youth coaches or tutors? Partner with Red Dept &
    Schools to establish programs for high school seniors and recent graduates.
- 6. Help with determining what jobs & what training is available
  - a. Resume creation & application help
  - Understand the Town's job market and trends for educational needs and candidate job placement
  - c. Mentoring Programs, Job Shadowing, Job placement
- 7. Educational support (GED/AHD) resource how to obtain whether COA or online.
- 8. Offer a public forum in which all citizens can discuss sensitive topics to effect change and promote unity.
- 9. Promote unity by raising funds to support youth activities or scholarships.
