

Edenton Town Council Minutes
Special Meeting
November 25, 2019

The Edenton Town Council met in special session on Monday, November 25, 2019 in the Council Chambers. The following members were present: Mayor Roland Vaughan, Councilman Elton Bond, Councilman Samuel Dixon, Councilman Craig Miller, Councilman Roscoe Poole and Councilman Jimmy Stallings. Absent Councilman Steve Biggs.

Mayor Roland Vaughan called the meeting to order.

The first item on the agenda was a public hearing for a public nuisance at 115 Oakdale Drive.

Ms. Knighton stated that she and the Planner have been working with the building inspector on a nuisance abatement project at 115 Oakdale Drive, a singlewide trailer that needs to be removed. She reported that the property owner has been notified and all advertisements have been completed for the public hearing and property has been posted.

Holly Colombo, Building Inspector, gave his final report on the property. He stated that this process started in February 2019. The property owner was interested in having the fire department burn the property down. The condition of the property is very bad and is a public nuisance and safety hazard.

Mr. Colombo stated that he would have to talk with Fire Chief Bass to see if the structure could be burned since with was a mobile home.

Mayor Vaughan opened the floor for public comment.

There being no comments from the public, the public hearing was closed.

A motion was made by Councilman Stallings to adopt the ordinance to abate the public nuisance at 115 Oakdale Drive. Councilman Miller seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

The second item on the agenda was Resolution of Support – Kadesh Church, North Oakum Street Redevelopment Zone.

Ms. Knighton stated that Council is being asked to adopt a resolution of support for the restoration of the Kadesh Church property on East Gale Street. The town has been working on the redevelopment zone in which Kadesh Church is the heart and soul of the neighborhood and redevelopment zone since 2014.

Councilman Dixon made a motion to approve the resolution of support. Councilman Stallings seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

There being no further items on the special meeting agenda, the meeting was adjourned.
